## EXPLORING INUIT CULTURE CURRICULUM

A multi-media exploration of the Canadian Arctic

*Exploring Inuit Culture Curriculum (EICC)* is a multi-media unit of instruction designed to teach students about the Inuit of Nunavut, the newest territory in Canada established in 1999. This curriculum is unique not only because of the subject matter, but because it explores a native culture through its own eyes, as opposed to the eyes of outsiders.

The content of *EICC* supports the subjects of Canadian Studies and native cultures, two topics found in elementary level social studies curricula. In addition, *EICC* integrates language arts, science, technology, music, art and drama, fulfilling other required curriculum components and creating a comprehensive unit of study.

Using a combination of authentic materials developed by the Inuit of Nunavut, Canada and lesson plans aligned to elementary curricula, students have the opportunity to explore the rich Inuit culture and unique Canadian Arctic from the perspective of its native people.
